

Pine Plains Central School District 2018-19 Board of Education Goals

1. Curriculum and Instruction

- a) The percentage of Regents diplomas with advanced designation shall be at least 50%.
- b) The percentage of the four year cohort achieving a diploma in June 2019 shall be at least 95%.
- c) Continue to monitor the long term effectiveness of the pre-kindergarten program.
- d) Continue to maintain opportunities for students with disabilities to participate in regular classes and extracurricular programs. Ensure students with disabilities have the ability to participate in any school function.
- e) Achieve the targets set for students' academic growth in grades K – 8 in MAP testing as determined by the building principal.
- f) Reduce opt-out rate for the State Standardize testing to under 27%.
- g) Evaluate the AIS program, restructure as needed.
- h) Resolve the future of the Chinese language program.
- i) Establish social/emotional/wellbeing program at both the elementary and secondary levels.

2. Technology

- a) Identify the academic impact of the use of the deployed technology.
- b) Evaluate the effectiveness of the new Technology Integrator position.

3. Business and Finance

- a) Demonstrate fiscal stability and reasonable tax rate by developing a thorough and thoughtful budget process.
- b) Promote the BOCES Capital Project and encourage residents / employees to vote for this project.
- c) Create a five year plan for areas to be audited by our internal auditor.
- d) Avoid repeat audit findings for all audits.

4. Facilities

- a) Continue to revise and update our five year facilities plan.
- b) Oversee the implementation of the energy performance project.
- c) Oversee the Auditorium project.
- d) Track environmental issues, excessive heat, mold, lead, etc. Devise a plan to remedy issues.
- e) Find alternative funding to complete all portions of the voter approved capital project for gymnasium floor.

5. Community

- a) Continue the emphasis on parent and community involvement by creating venues that will increase public relations.
- b) Create one single district wide calendar for easy to find information.
