2022-2023 SCHOOL TAX COLLECTION

I, Joan C. Taylor, School Tax Collector, have received the Tax Warrant for the collection of school taxes for the Pine Plains Central School District. Taxes can be paid in the following manner:

By Drop Box: Located at Stissing Mountain Junior / Senior High School, Main Entrance (Center Doors) Hours: Mon – Fri, 7:00 am – 5:00 pm (Closed Labor Day, 9/5/22 and Columbus Day, 10/10/22). Check or Money order only.

Online payment: Available for the first time, as a pilot program, payments can safely be made online by credit card or by e-check. Specific directions can be found on the information sheet included with your tax bill or on the District Website:

Collection of taxes will begin on September 1, 2022 and will end October 31, 2022. School taxes paid and/or postmarked during the first 30-day period, September 1, 2022 to and including September 30, 2022 will be penalty free. School taxes paid October 1, 2022 to and including October 31, 2022 must include the two percent (2%) penalty or the payment will be returned.

Please be advised that the Board of Education of the Pine Plains Central School District has adopted a Tax Installment Payment Option for Dutchess County Property Taxpayers only. Taxpayers may pay school taxes in two (2) installments pursuant to Dutchess County Local Law no. 4 of 1978. The first school tax installment of 50% of the tax due together with a five percent (5%) fee is due by September 15, 2022 payable to the Pine Plains School Tax Collector and the second installment of 50% of the tax due, together with a five percent (5%) fee, is due no later than March 15, 2023 made payable and mailed directly to the Dutchess County Commissioner of Finance.

The collection period with the two percent (2%) penalty will conclude on October 31, 2022 and all unpaid tax records will be returned to the County Treasurer. After that date, payment of school taxes can be made by contacting the County Commissioner of Finance.
